If your case is scheduled for 1:30 p.m. please arrive in the Supreme Court Courtroom by 1:15 p.m. for a brief orientation when the Clerk is available. Attorneys who have uncommon requests or specific problems should be present earlier or contact the Clerk in advance of the hearing date. The Clerk will be available in the courtroom at 8:30 a.m. on the morning of the docket.

The Court will call each case on the docket individually when the case is ready for argument. Failure to appear when your case is called on the appropriate docket constitutes a waiver of oral argument. See Supreme Court Rule 7.01(d).
