**Order Suspending Certified Copies Requirement under Supreme Court Rule 2.04**

This order complements Administrative Orders 2020-PR-13, 2020-PR-15 and 2020-PR-16 on actions to mitigate local or statewide outbreak of the COVID-19 disease.

On March 18, 2020, the Chief Justice of the Kansas Supreme Court, in consultation with the members of the Kansas Supreme Court, issued Administrative Order 2020-PR-16, imposing statewide judiciary restricted operations due to the COVID-19 emergency.

Due to those restricted operations, this order temporarily suspends the requirement under Supreme Court Rule 2.04 (as amended effective March 27, 2019) that certified copies of documents must be submitted when docketing an appeal. During restricted operations, only file-stamped copies of documents are required to docket an appeal.
