

A National Day of Mourning for the death of former President Jimmy Carter will be observed as a day of leave on January 9, 2025, under the Kansas Court Personnel Rules, and in concurrence with actions taken by the federal government and Governor Laura Kelly. The National Day of Mourning will be observed as a holiday for time computation purposes.

In the interest of justice, the Chief Judge of each judicial district may authorize the conduct of any court proceedings scheduled for that day.
